The State House and COSI are within walking distance. The Kelton House (part of the Underground Railroad), the James Thurber House, the Fire Museum, the Columbus Museum of Art, and the Topiary Gardens are also located in downtown Columbus. The Ohio Historical Society and Franklin Park Conservatory are ten minutes away.
